CONSTRUCTION PLANNED

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) plans improvements to the intersection of U.S. 20 and Idaho Highway 47 here in Ashton. Improvements will include some reconfiguration of the intersection; a traffic signal/turn light;

and curb, gutter and sidewalk along U.S. 20.

The City Council and Police Department provided input on the proposed project. Enhancements are designed to improve traffic safety and flow

for motorists and pedestrians alike. ITD anticipates construction of the project in 2020.

NEWS FROM THE CITY



The Ashton City Pool is opening on June 15th. Citizens and patrons should be aware that there are basic rules to be allowed to swim at the pool. The City is required to post the rules at the pool.

Here is a list of the rules:

- * Persons having an infectious or communicable disease that can be transmitted through the water shall be excluded from swimming.
- * Contamination of water, walkways or dressing room floors in any way is prohibited.
- * No glass containers allowed in the pool area.
- * Children under 10 years of age MUST be accompanied by an ADULT 18 years or older.
- * Children 4 years old and under must be accompanied in the water by an adult 18 years or older.
- * Children in diapers MUST wear a swim diaper.
- * Patrons MUST be 48 inches tall to use the slide.
- * Only one patron at a time are allowed to use the slide
- * Dive at your own risk.
- * No running on diving board
- * Only one patron at a time on the diving board.
- * No flips or twists from the diving board.
- * Patrons must shower with soap before entering the pool, completely rinsing.
- * All long hair must be tied back.
- * No profanity, running or rough play.
- * No spitting, spouting water, splashing, blowing nose, etc.
- * No public display of affection.
- * No food or drink in the pool area.
- * NO REFUNDS
- * Management may prohibit large inflatable toys.
- * No toys in the deep end.
- * We have the right to refuse use of the pool to anyone.
- * We ask that all patrons be listed as they enter the pool for safety reasons.

The City of Ashton is committed to making the pool a SAFE place. It is a great place to have fun and keep COOL!

Door to Door Sales



As per Ashton City Code, door to door sales are not allowed.

The Code reads: 5.16.010: *The practice of going in and upon private residences in the city by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants and transient vendors of merchandise,*

not having been requested or invited to do so by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants, of said private residence, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares and merchandise is declared to be a nuisance, and punishable as such nuisance as a

misdemeanor.

If a salesman does stop by your door, please notify the City Building at 652-3987. We will notify the City Police and they will notify the salesman that they are not allowed to sell door to door.

FIREWORK SAFETY

The last several years the City Police Department has been noticing an increase in complaints concerning fireworks.

As per Ashton City Code section 8.12.010., the City has adopted the Idaho State Code on fireworks (title 39, chapter 26).

This code allows citizens to use "Nonaerial common fireworks"

which are fireworks that do not fly or emit sparks outside a 20 foot diameter circle or higher than 20 feet. Firecrackers are also prohibited.

The City police are asking citizens to be mindful of their neighbors and to be cautious around any fire hazards. They are also encouraging parents to be watching their kids closely while handling fireworks.

Let's celebrate the Fourth of July safely!

We will be enforcing these laws this year.
